Ukraine in war - 11 years

More than 1,000 attacks on healthcare facilities recorded

About 200 people died in hospitals, 140 were injured


- 2400 medical facilities were damaged

- 300 health facilities were destroyed

- More than 500 ended up in temporarily occupied territory



Kharkiv, Donetsk, Mykolaiv, Kherson and Chernihiv regions were the most affected.

priorities**



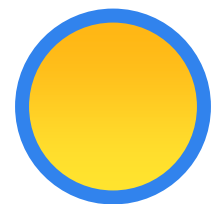
Energy independence deficit: Hospitals need autonomous power sources and energy-efficient equipment.

Staff shortage: Need for rapid training of personnel in the use of new technologies.

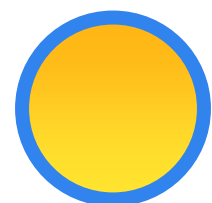
Mental trauma and rehabilitation: Enormous strain on the psychological support and physical rehabilitation system.

Demographic crisis: Development of reproductive technologies and improvement of women's and children's health.

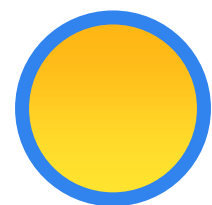




Frontline and de-occupied territories (east and south) require mobile solutions;

training centers for medics and civilians - ASSET, ATLS, BLS, TCCC, ETC with VR/AR

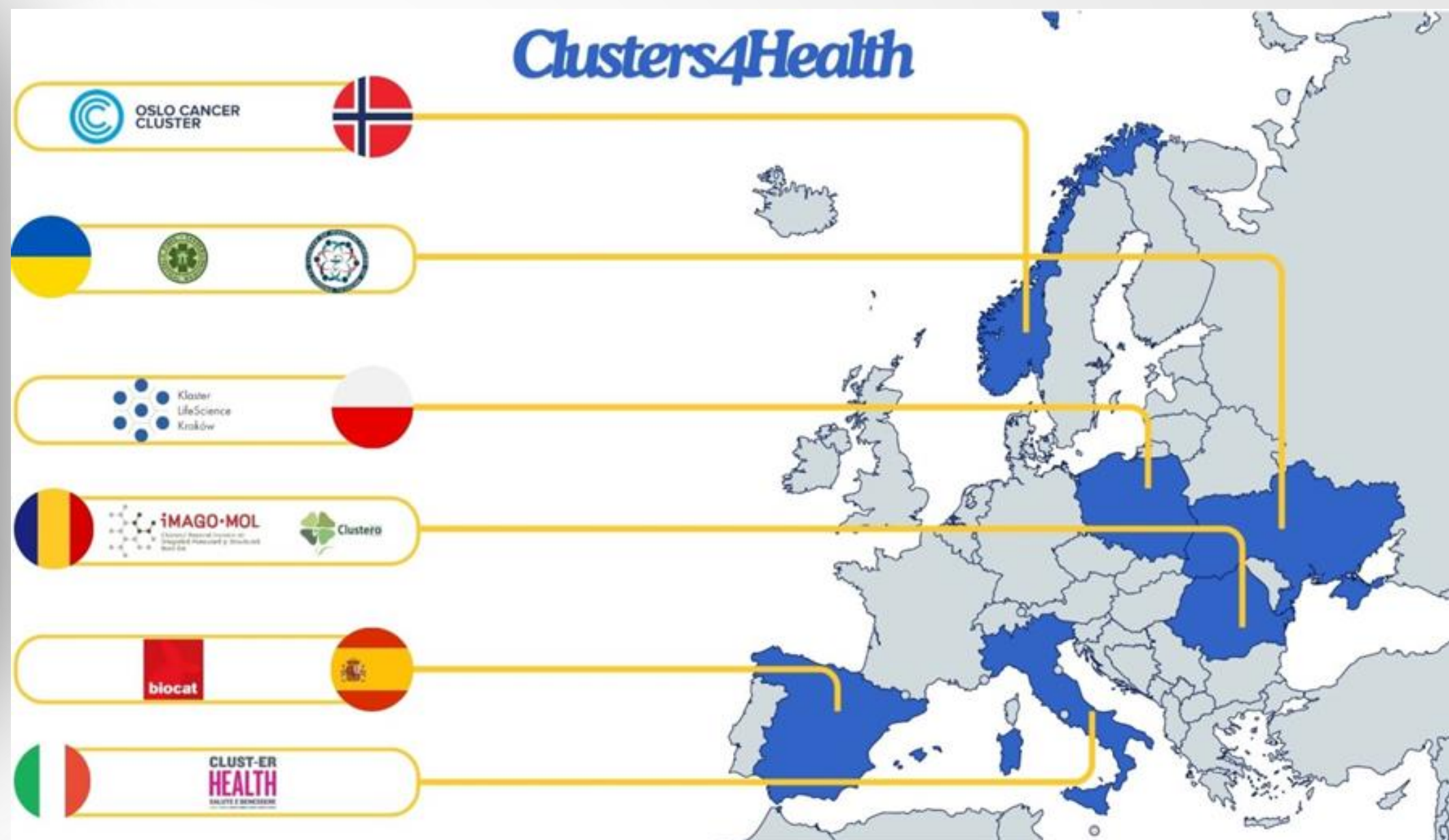
equipment for rehabilitation and prosthetic centers, mental health

Clusters4Health overview



The goal of the **Clusters4Health** is to **foster innovation, collaboration, excellence and growth** within the **medical clusters in Ukraine**, by **building a collaboration framework** with **European healthtech clusters**.





Reduced barriers: Simplified certification: Fast-track procedures for the recognition of certificates apply for EU marked products.

Public procurement: Ukraine ratified the EU Treaty on Joint Procurement of Medical Protection (February 2026), paving the way for transparent tenders



Grants and funding

Horizon Europe: Health Program for 2026-2027 with a budget of over 470 million euros (available for joint UA-EU consortia).

GIZ and KfW: German agencies actively finance the purchase of equipment and training of personnel.

Medical Guarantee Program (MGP NHSU): Over 191 billion UAH has been allocated for 2026, which guarantees payment for services to clinics with modern equipment.
