Building on the promising results of last year's Energy Roundtable and the 2nd German-Romanian Business Conference in Berlin, the event pursues the goal of highlighting Romania's role in energy policy on the one hand, informing about the country's development perspectives and goals in the energy sector, and exploring concrete cooperation potentials for politics and companies on the other hand.
