- Cross-cultural training of scholarship holders prior to their stay in Germany

Since 2004, more than 1000 young professionals have been participating in the Internship Programme of German Business. After finishing their internships in Germany, the scholarship holders remain part of the Programme as members of the Programme's regional Alumni Network.
